Currently, 71.0% of the 49,130 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 24.8%, renter occupied; and 4.2% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 55.7% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.8% are renter occupied; and 11.6% are vacant. In 2010, there were 47,767 housing units in the area - 73.5% owner occupied, 21.1% renter occupied, and 5.5% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 1.26%. Median home value in the area is \$193,063, compared to a median home value of \$200,006 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 3.14% annually to \$225,391.
