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Currently, 71.6% of the 7,427 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 20.7%, renter occupied; and 7.6% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 55.7% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.8% are renter occupied; and 11.6% are vacant. In 2010, there were 6,889 housing units in the area - 74.3% owner occupied, 17.4% renter occupied, and 8.3% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 3.40%. Median home value in the area is \$191,337, compared to a median home value of \$200,006 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 4.48% annually to \$238,254.
